**RESOLUTION OF THE OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS FIRE DISTRICT #6, TOWNSHIP OF GLOUCESTER, CAMDEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE ENTERING INTO A SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR A FIRE OFFICIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM WITH VARIOUS FIRE DISTRICTS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF GLOUCESTER.**

**WHEREAS.** The Board of Fire Commissioners Fire District #6 of the Township of Gloucester has determined that entering into a shared services agreement with various Fire Districts within the Township of Gloucester is cost effective and beneficial to the residents of the Fire District, and will result in an improved and more consistent fire official/investigator services throughout the Township, and


**WHEREAS.** The Township of Gloucester is in agreement with entering into a Fire Official Assistance Program between Fire Districts # 2, 4, 5, and 6, and

**WHEREAS.** the Uniform Shared Services Act (N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq.) authorizes and empowers the Fire Districts to enter into this Agreement.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of Fire Commissioners Fire District #6 of the Township of Gloucester that the Fire District is hereby authorized to enter into a municipal shared services agreement between participating Fire District # 2, 4, 5 and 6 of the Township of Gloucester for Fire Official Assistance Program, a copy of which agreement to be placed on file and made a part hereof.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** by the Board of Fire Commissioners that the signing of the shared services agreement is conditioned upon Fire Districts # 2, 4, 5 and 6 equally signing and participating in the program.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** by the Board of Fire Commissioners that the signing of the shared services agreement is conditioned upon the initial term of the shared services agreement shall be for a term ending December 31<sup>st</sup> 2018, at which time Fire District #6 shall either terminate its participation or renew for an extended period.
